## **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**

The Club Championship is coming up on October 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, and 28<sup>th</sup>. Amy Ng and Tina Low will have a sign up sheet at the course for you to be able to sign up. If you are not going to be at the course and want to play, let Tina and Amy know so that they can get you signed up. This is a 3 week commitment to play and you need to play all 3 games.

## **TEE TIMES**

There continues to be problems with getting extra tee times from the Pro Shop when more members sign up that we have tee times for. We are given 11 team times each week. The last time we got extra tee times there were problems with members because of different things.

A decision was made by the Pro Shop that if we need extra tee times they have to be requested by the Monday afternoon a week before they are needed. That is the only way we can get extra tee times.

We have a Couples Tournament that will be held on September 23<sup>rd</sup>. This tournament was changed from December to our guest day in September because of weather problems that has cancelled the tournament in the last years. Each member must bring a guest to play in the tournament. It does not need to be a male. Two members will not be allowed to play as a team in this event. This will also be a no sweeps day but each player will pay \$5 for sweeps at check in.

You must make a commitment to play and bring a guest by Friday, September 12th so that Paulette will be able to know how many extra tee times are needed for Tuesday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>.

If you do not have a guest to play in the tournament with, you will be able to play at the end of the field but not participate in the tournament if we can get all of the extra tee times that will be needed for the tournament.

Also on guest day, each member should ask her guest to wait for her to check in at the desk so that they can be given the proper instructions. Make sure your guest takes a scorecard and fills it out as the other players in the foursome.

## **STARTER/SCORER DUTIES**

We have had only person that has not shown up or gotten a substitute for her duties. This has resulted in a \$50 fine, \$25 for starter, \$25 for scorer. Please be aware that it is your responsibility to find your own substitute when you have a duty. You need to sign up with Paulette Wrightson if you want to play on the day you are doing your duty. You will not be assigned a tee time automatically.

Also the Desk opens at 7:15 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. Please check in 30 minutes before your tee time or by 8:30 AM and no later. If there are play days when there are extra tee times the desk will remain open until 9:00 AM.

If you have any Rules questions, don't hesitate to email Sue Kaupp and get her to help. The course has a local rule posted for holes that are under construction on the bulletin board outside of the Pro Shop and also on any hole that is affected.
