### **RULES-Joyce Bartlett**

**Rule 12. Searching for and Identifying Ball: This rule allows players to lift a ball without penalty to identify it except in a hazard. Before lifting the ball, the player must announce his intention to fellow players and mark the position of the ball. If the lifted ball is the player's ball, it must be replaced recreating the original lie as closely as possible. So even though we are playing the ball down, you are entitled to identify your ball and avoid getting a 2 stroke penalty for hitting a wrong ball. Note that in a hazard there is no penalty for hitting a wrong ball.**
