The membership has voted to change the standing rule for credit for playing team play for Shoreline. The amended standing rule will now read:

When a member represents Shoreline in a Santa Clara County Team Play or P.W. Zone Team Play event, if played on a Tuesday, member will get a full game credit. If played on any other day, member will get a 1/2 game credit. These credits will count toward the annual 10 game requirement.

RULES

The Shoreline Women's Club has decided to adopt the local rule 24 in the USGA rulebook pertaining to immovable and moveable obstructions. The changes will be in your new handbook for 2006 which is when we will start being able to use them. The main differences will be that you will be able to remove stones and pebbles from the bunkers and you will be able to get relief from sprinkler heads around the green so you don't have to putt over them.
