PWGA

The new PWGA handbooks with all of the tournament sign up sheets and information from PWGA are here for 2007. Pick up your book if this is your home club. Also pay attention to the play days, which will be coming out by email for you to sign up for. You will need to send a check to Nancy Humpal for your entry fee to play on a play day.

STATS

Our new Stats Director has asked for a change on the scorecards. Please write your full name on the scorecard starting with your last name first. Scorecards still need to be filled out in handicap order. Please write in legible handwriting so she does not have to guess whom the person is.

HANDICAP

The handicap director has requested that you post at the golf course after your round. Do not post at home. She checks the posting and if you post at home you get posted twice.

Also Namie Takatsuka has done a great job in re-handicapping the holes. New scorecards will begin on March 13th. Pay attention to the new handicap holes when you are popping your cards for the team games.

TEE TIMES

Please pay attention when you have signed up in the book that you have not signed up twice. This makes it a little difficult when putting the tee times together and your name is down twice.

If you are going to cancel, please do it as soon as possible because we are getting a lot of play and people are on the waiting list. It does not help the person who is on the wait list if you cancel at 6:30 in the morning. It is too late to get her in.

We are in the same position at the Pro Shop as we were last year. There are too many cancellations for us to get extra tee times. Until we can prove that we can fill our 11 tee times and keep them filled, they will not give us extra tee times. A big effort from all will help to accomplish this.

TOURNAMENT

There have been a lot of complaints about the bird “crap” on the golf course. The golf course maintenance group is trying everything that they are allowed to do to keep the coots off the greens and in the water. Volunteers are being used to keep them off of the greens, and a second dog has been brought in. Seems there are more coots this year than before and it has caused a lot of frustration for golfers and the golf course personnel.

Until the golf course has returned to somewhat normal, we will be playing winter rules or preferred lies. This means pick, clean and place within 6 inches. Remember to mark your ball before picking it up and once it has been placed, it cannot be placed again.

Our club pays closest to the pin on a hole on the front nine and back nine. It only pays one place per hole. If you are not closer than the persons already on the slip, please do not put your name on the slip.

SPECIAL TOURNAMENTS

The Match Play tournament is coming up in April. It is April 10, 17 and 24th. Look for the sign up sheet at the course. The tournament directors are trying to put a day where there can be a match play warm up played in March. This way people who don't know how to play Match Play or know the rules can have a practice game to see how it is played.

RULES
