GUEST DAYS

Our first Guest Day is on May 29th. We have had many sign ups and have had to request extra tee times from the Pro Shop. The policy of the Club is that the members with guests will have priority over members without guests. For future guest days this policy remains in effect. This means that if you don't have a guest, and we have a full field, you may not be able to play that day if we cannot get additional times from the Pro Shop.

Please read the Standing Rules in the Roster Book on Guest Days. Invited guests must have an established handicap. If you bring a guest that does not have an established handicap, she will not be allowed to play.

When there are additional tee times for Guest Days, the Starters will keep the Desk Open until 9:00 a.m. and will not close at 8:30. If you are a starter on a Guest Day, please be prepared to remain until 9:00.

TEE TIMES

If you are going to cancel, please do it as soon as possible because we are getting a lot of play and people are on the waiting list. It does not help the person who is on the wait list if you cancel at 6:30 in the morning. It is too late to get her in.

We are in the same position at the Pro Shop as we were last year. There are too many cancellations for us to get extra tee times. Until we can prove that we can fill our 11 tee times and keep them filled, they will not give us extra tee times. A big effort from all will help to accomplish this.

TOURNAMENT

Summer Rules are in effect unless otherwise noted. The new Local Rule of Bird Droppings makes this possible. If you are not aware of the new Local Rule it is:

If a player's ball lies on, next to or has feces adhering to the ball, the player may mark, lift, clean the ball and place it within 6 inches of the original spot, no closer to the hole.
